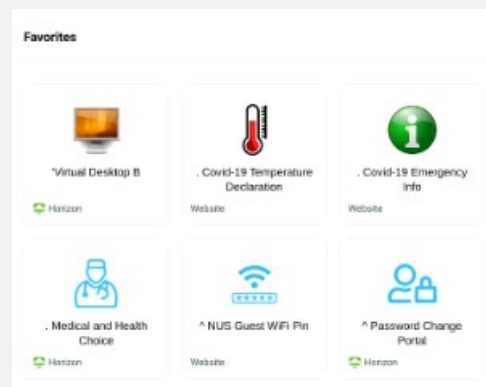


Staff Virtual Desktop with Chromebook

What is Staff Virtual Desktop?

It is a service which provides staff with a Windows 10 virtual environment that runs from high-performance backend servers.

- A Windows 10 virtual desktop with common software
- Access to a catalogue of NUS Applications
- Minimise Logins to NUS Applications
- Seamlessly access NUS Applications from off campus

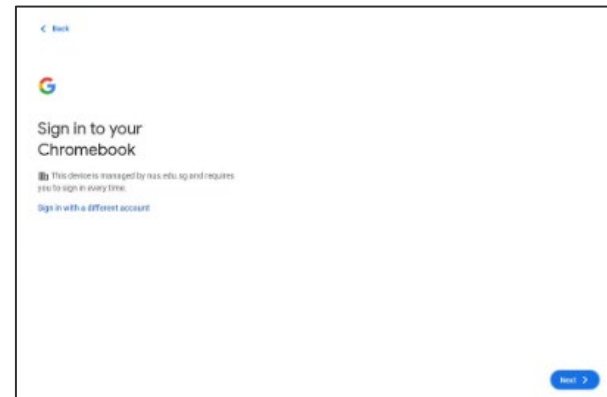
Why use Chromebook?

It has a formfactor of a laptop providing mobile access to Staff Virtual Desktop from anywhere.

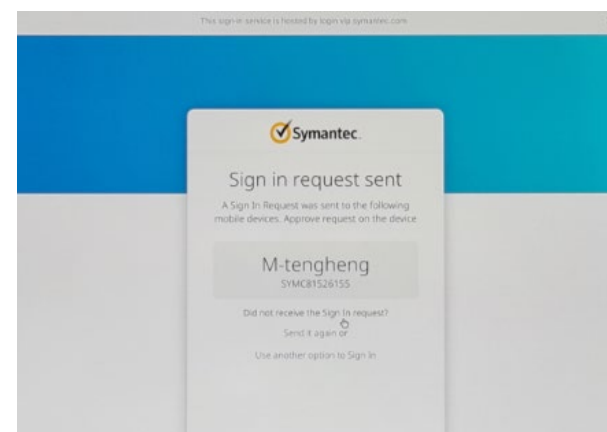


Step 1. Login

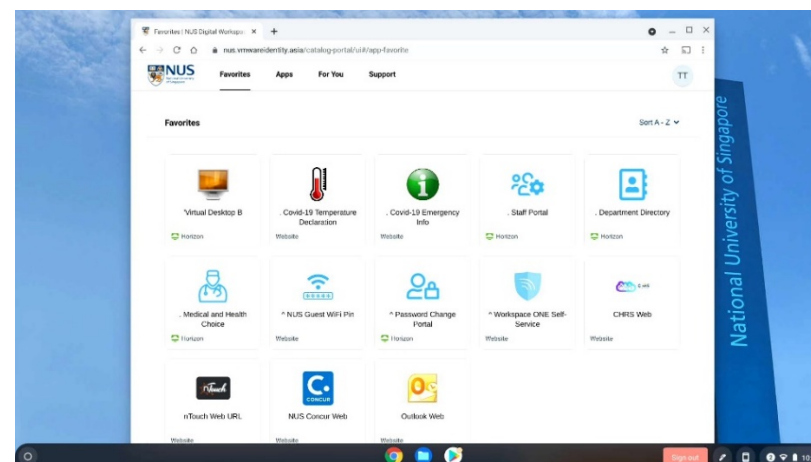


Follow thru the **Sign In** and **2FA** process.

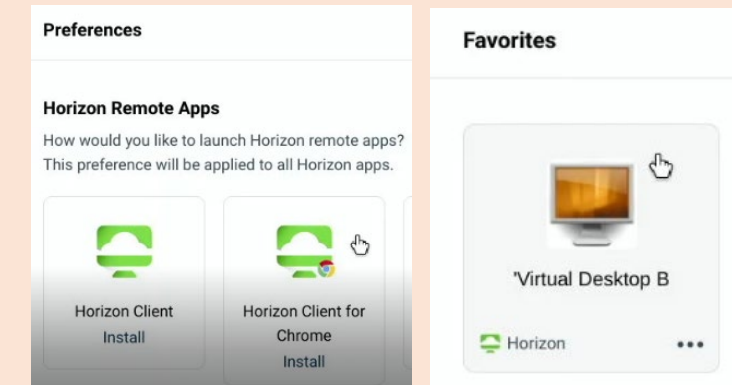


Step 2. Chrome OS

Launch **Staff Virtual Desktop** or any NUS applications

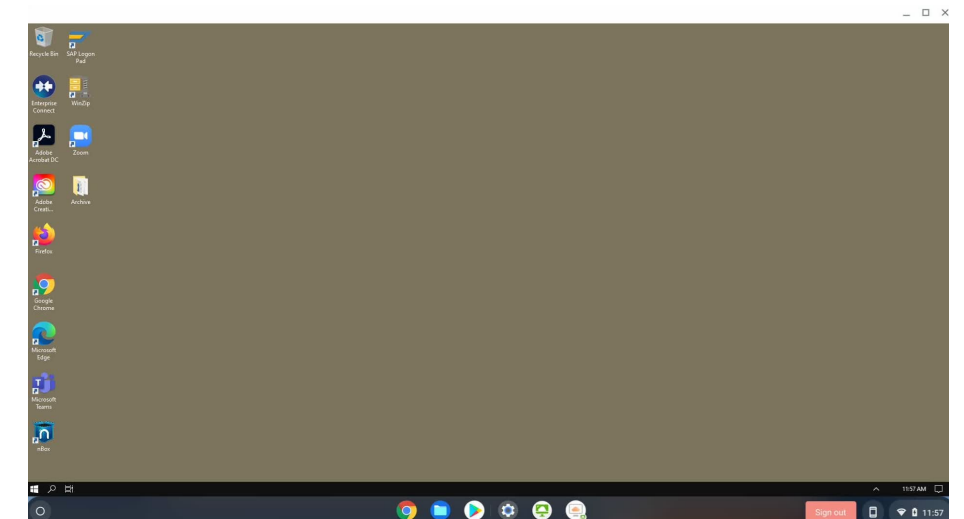


Step 3. Launch into Virtual Desktop A or B

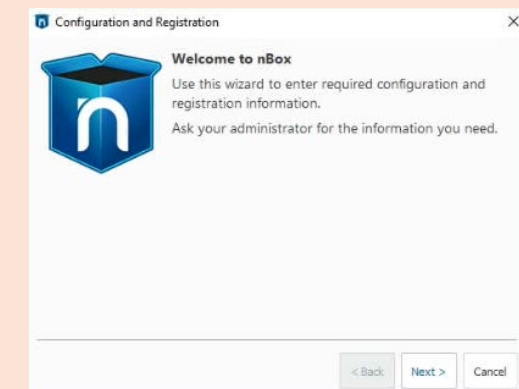


Set Chrome Client as default once. Click on VD icon to launch from now on.
